Application Guidelines:

Candidates must:

1. Be a graduating high school senior.
2. Be the child of a First Responder, paid or non-paid, who works in Douglas, Sarpy, or Pottawattamie County.
3. Have a "C" or higher grade point average in high school.
4. Demonstrate good character, balanced achievement, outstanding commitment to community, and interest in furthering their success.
5. If selected:
 - a. Allow name and photo to be used by the First Responders Foundation.
 - b. Provide a photo to the First Responders Foundation
 - c. Attend an honorary reception on Tue. April 25th at 6 pm (if at all possible).

Selection Guidelines:

1. Selection shall be made by the First Responders Foundation selection committee.
2. Candidates do not have to show financial need.
3. Selection shall not be based on consideration of age, sex, race, creed, or disability.
4. There is a limited number of Awards of Excellence awards.
5. Winners will be announced on or about March 29, 2023, at www.firstrespondersfoundation.org.
